

RHEUMATOLOGY CONSULTATION

CHIEF COMPLAINT:

- 1. Small bowel obstruction.
- 2. Aching joints.
- 3. Fever.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS:

The patient is a 29-year-old female who noted about three years ago she developed significant polyarthralgia. At that time, an ANA was positive. No other diagnosis was made. She was told she had lupus but with time, the symptoms totally resolved. She apparently was essentially normal, leading a normal life, working and active, when in December 1996 she again developed a significant polyarthralgia beginning in her hands and her knees, becoming more generalized and increasing in severity to where it became essentially intolerable to her. During this time, she also noted some fatigue with possibly low grade fever. She did not have any alopecia, dryness of the eyes or mouth, swelling of any lymph nodes or glands in her neck that she is aware of. There was no history of pleurisy or pericarditis, no skin changes, no Raynaud's phenomenon. Other than this, however, she did feel generally tired.

Because of these symptoms and their progressive nature, she made an appointment at UC San Francisco where she was finally seen on January 23, 1997. Lab tests were done. Based on the fact that she may have early lupus, steroids were given, more for symptomatic relief. She took a low dose of 10 mg. Within about three days of this, she got acutely more ill, began to have nausea and vomiting, could not hold down her food. She also had abdominal discomfort. She was seen in Yuma, Arizona, where she was visiting with her mother. She was thought to have some evidence of small bowel obstruction and was treated for this over a weekend. However, because of increasing symptoms of fever, increasing problems with her joints, and incapacity, she was apparently transferred to Scripps Memorial for further treatment.

The patient notes that during this time she was called from San Francisco and told that the other tests they had run were now available and that she definitely had lupus, and her steroids were increased to 30 mg prior to her admission on February 2, 1997. The patient does not note any other symptom complex at this time. There is no past history of recurrent abortions, vascular accidents, clotting or bleeding problems. She has not had any other known infectious disease. She was in Argentina over the summer. She is not aware of any exposure to hepatitis, HIV potential essentially zero. There is no other history here of any exposure that might have given her a significant bacterial gastroenteritis or infection. The patient's bowel movements have essentially been unchanged. There is no blood or mucus and no apparent cramping with her stools. Other than this, the patient notes no specific chest or other complaints.

I am seeing the patient post laparotomy. She had evidence of small bowel obstruction with signs suggesting a tumor and was operated on an emergency basis. No biopsies were obtained, but she was palpated and observed, and no obstructive lesions were found other than edema and some ascitic fluid.

The patient has not noted any other connective tissue disease type complaints. She has never had thyroid disease or other autoimmune disease in the past. She has been essentially well. She has a twin and the twin has no disease at this time.

PAST MEDICAL HISTORY:

Other than the noted arthralgia three years ago, is essentially normal for any major medical or surgical disease. In terms of childhood surgery she had an adenoidectomy, tympanic tubes.

ALLERGIES:

None except she has had reactions to CODEINE and also believes she may be allergic to SULFA, since her twin is in fact allergic to sulfa. She has not actually had reaction to this type medication.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS:

RESPIRATORY: Essentially normal now and in the past. She does not smoke or drink. She uses no illegal drugs, has never used any, certainly not intravenously. CARDIOVASCULAR: Negative. GASTROINTESTINAL: In the present history. GENITOURINARY: Negative. OBSTETRICS/GYNECOLOGIC: Negative. NEUROLOGIC: Essentially normal. She has had significant stress in her life. She is a poet, but other than that, there is no specific neurologic complaints. ALLERGIES: As noted.

FAMILY HISTORY:

Not significant for any kind of connective tissue disease.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION:

GENERAL APPEARANCE:

A young female who is in bed.

VITAL SIGNS:

Normal.

MUSCULOSKELETAL:

Hands, elbows and shoulders are normal. There is some puffiness of the hands and mild tenderness over the joints. There is no overt synovitis at this time.

LUNGS:

Clear.

ABDOMEN:

Not examined.

LYMPHATICS:

She does not have any obvious lymphadenopathy.

SKIN

No evidence of vasculitic change at this time.

LABORATORY STUDIES:

Extensive, and the major findings are that she has a high sedimentation rate, a high CRP, elevated liver enzymes, known positive ANA, mild anemia on the second postoperative and preceding this in Yuma, and some other minor electrolyte changes. A serum electrophoresis shows acute phase elevation with a low albumin. Other tests pending and to be obtained from San Francisco.

DIAGNOSIS:

- Lupus with probable hepatitis and small bowel obstruction.
- 2. Primary viral or other hepatitis with secondary lupus-like syndrome as a prodrome.

DISCUSSION

At this point in time, this young lady is complexly ill. She probably does have a connective tissue disease; lupus most likely, apparently tests from San Francisco, which I am going to presume were complement in order and antibodies were significantly positive, and this diagnosis was made at that time. She appears to have multisystem disease including liver, small bowel and anemia, etc. I think the treatment right now with steroids in a moderately high dose is adequate. If she does not respond, I think we may give her pulse steroids over the next three or four days.

The only other obvious possibility here is that she has a prodrome hepatitis. Her liver enzymes are significantly elevated now, and certainly the arthralgia illness and other symptoms could have been prodrome hepatitis. This will need to be reviewed.

I will follow along with Dr. Lenz.

Subject: REFUND ON RENT INCREASES - SAN QUENTIN STATE OWNED HOUSING

To resolve the issue of rent increases to employees that were not properly notified, checks have been issued for the amount of the increases as well as penalties. These checks are available in the Accounting Office.

As limited information was previously available the following shall provide information on how the refunds were calculated:

To determine the amount due to each employee the North Coast Regional Accounting Office took the amount of the November rent as the base rent and determined the amount overcharged from December 2005 through July 2006.

Penalties were also added based on figures provided by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation Legal Department. The rate utilized to calculate the penalties was .008333 per month. Based on the number of months the Department held the funds then determined the number of months to calculate the penalty amount. The penalties were calculated through September 2006 since checks were issued on October 1, 2006.

As an example, if the employee overpaid rent in December, the Department held the funds 10 months (December 2005-Sept 2006), January would be 9 months, etc. Adding all the months up and applying the rate gave us the amount of penalties due.

Although we appreciate the resolution to this portion of the process, the institution is still awaiting final decisions on the issues regarding taxation. We anticipate that this information will be forthcoming in the very near future.
